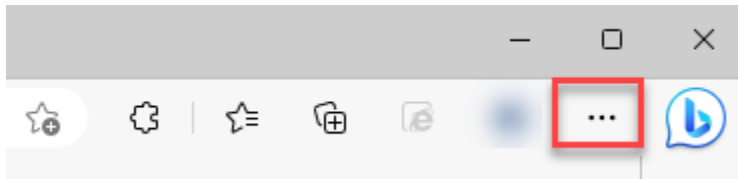

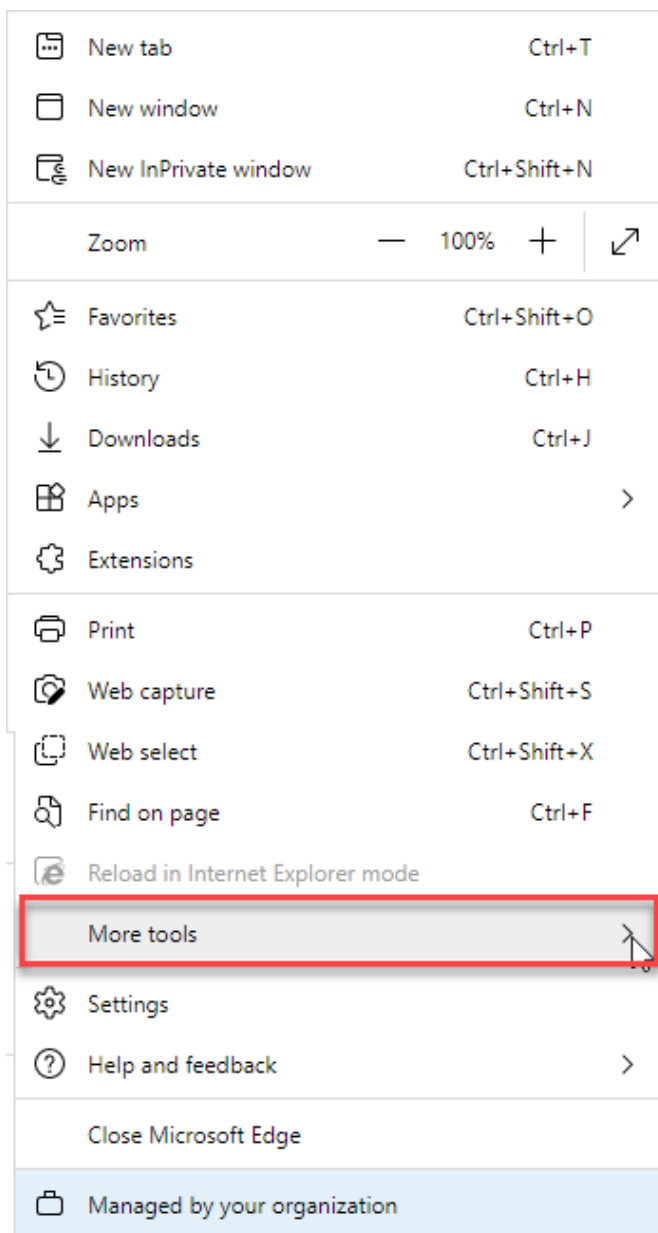

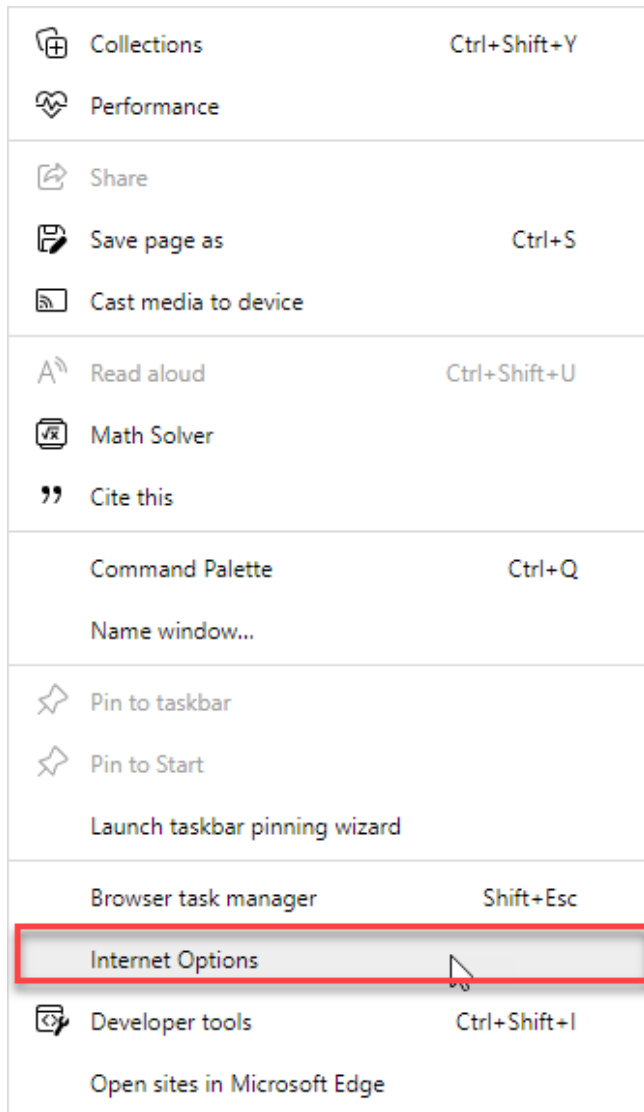
1.) In the upper right corner of the browser, click the three dots (...) to open the settings menu.



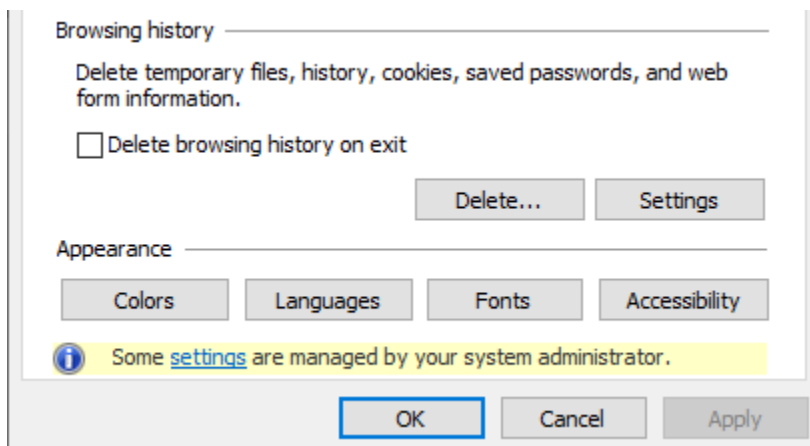
2.) Click "**More tools**".



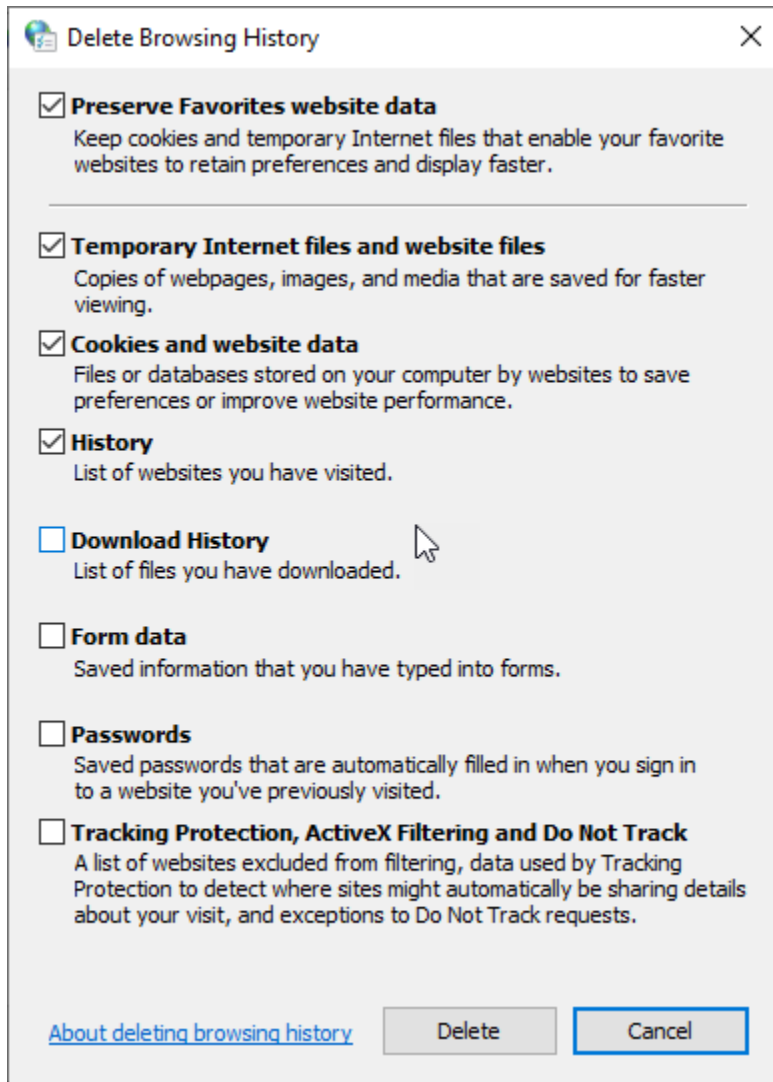
3.) Click "**Internet Options**".



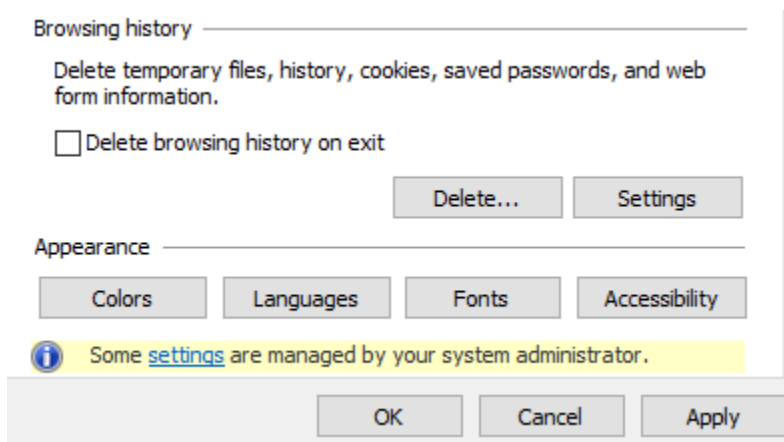
4.) Click "**Delete**".



5.) Click "**Delete**".

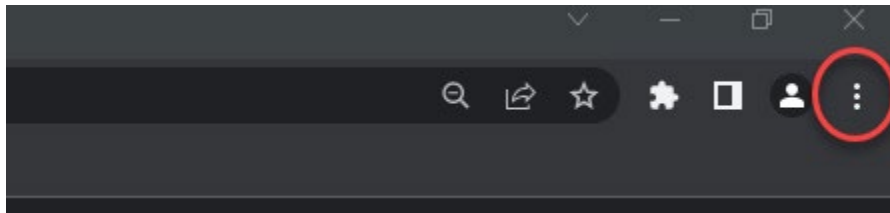


6.) Click "**Apply**" and then "**OK**".

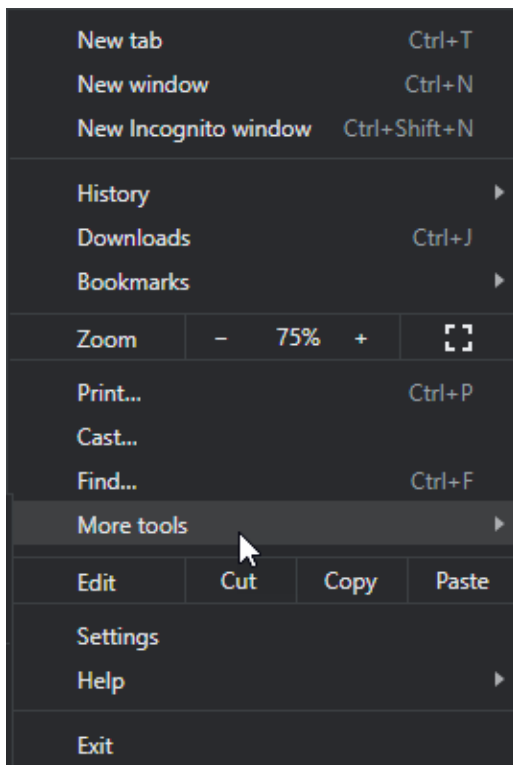


Google Chrome

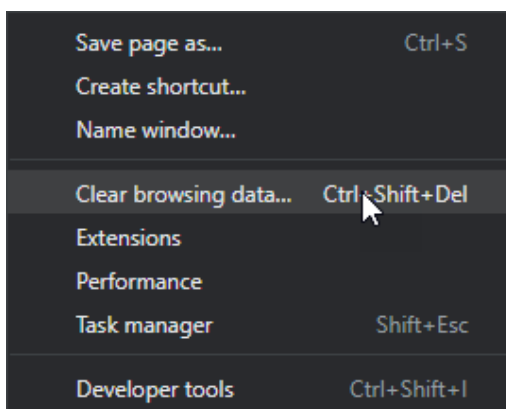
1. In the upper right corner, click the three dots(:).



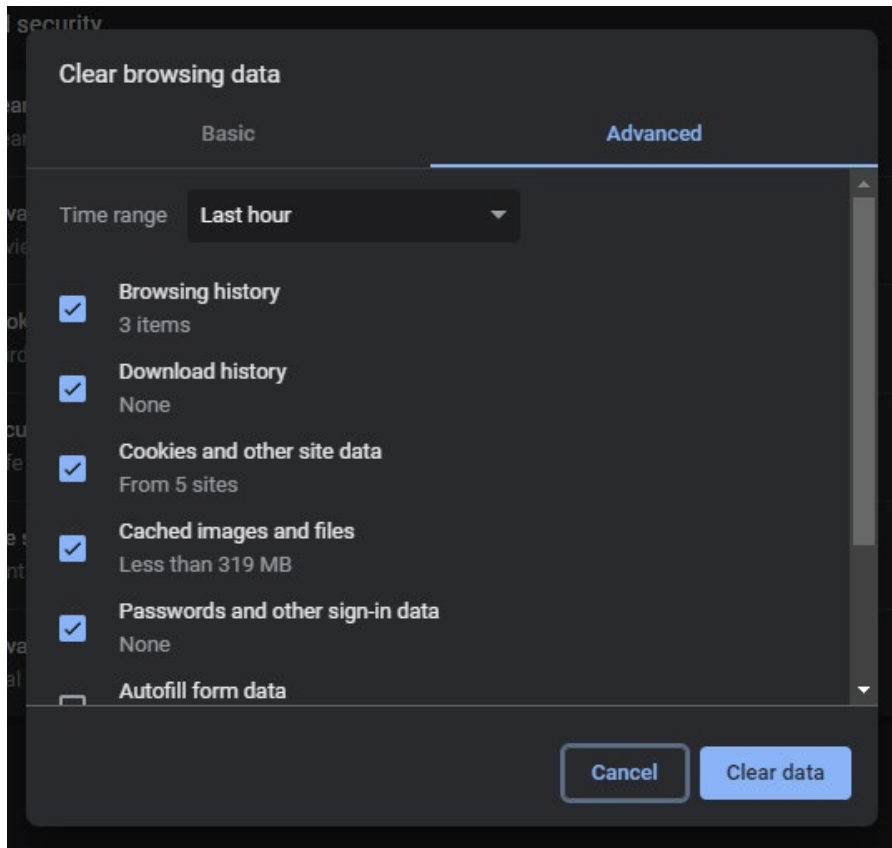
2. Click "**More tools**".



3. Click "**Clear browsing data...**".

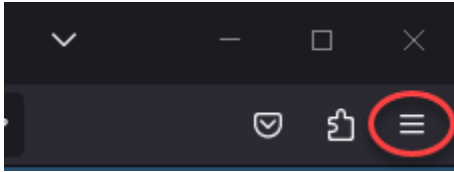


4. Click **“Clear data”**.

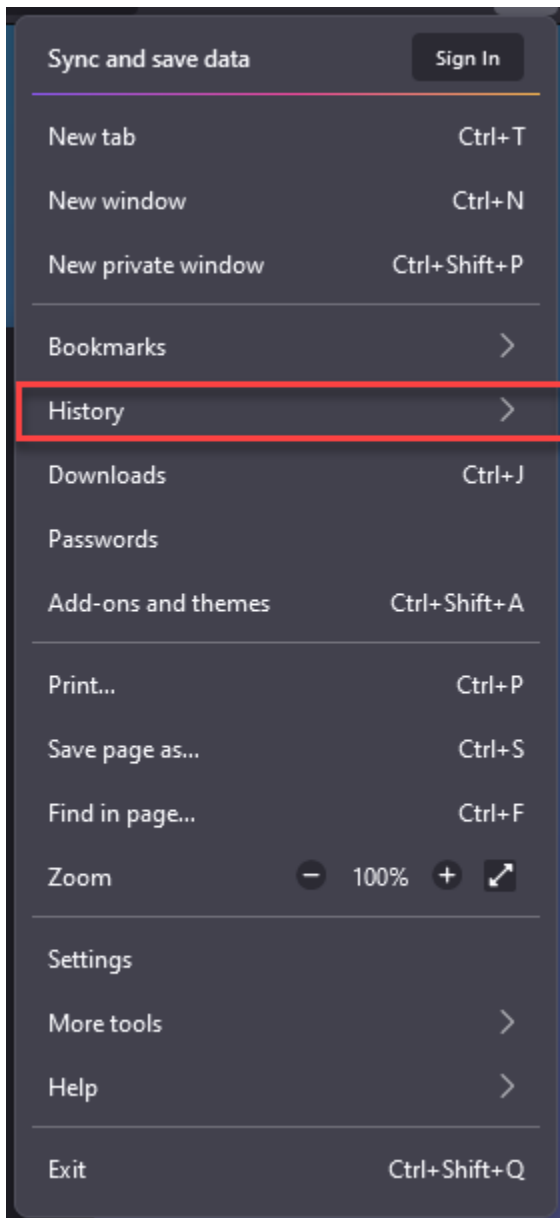


Mozilla Firefox

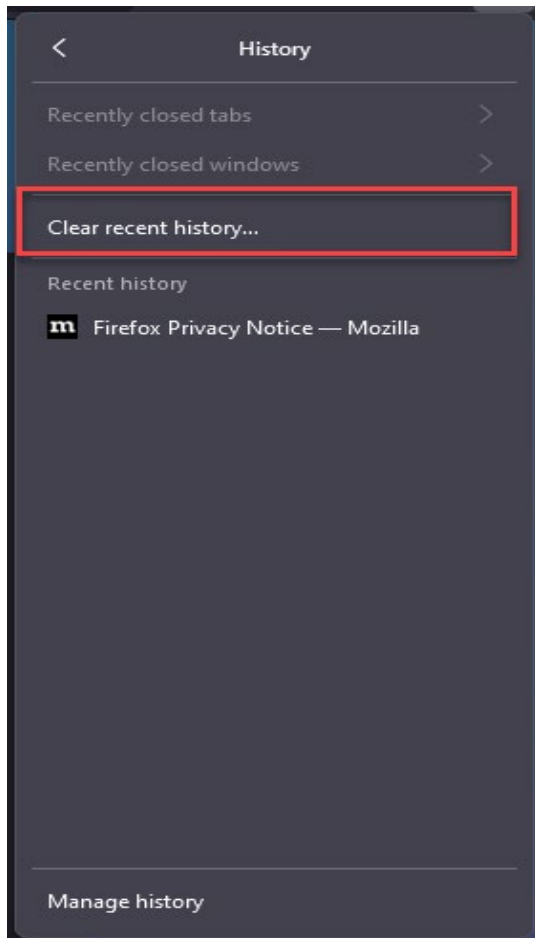
1. In the upper right corner click the three dashes (☰).



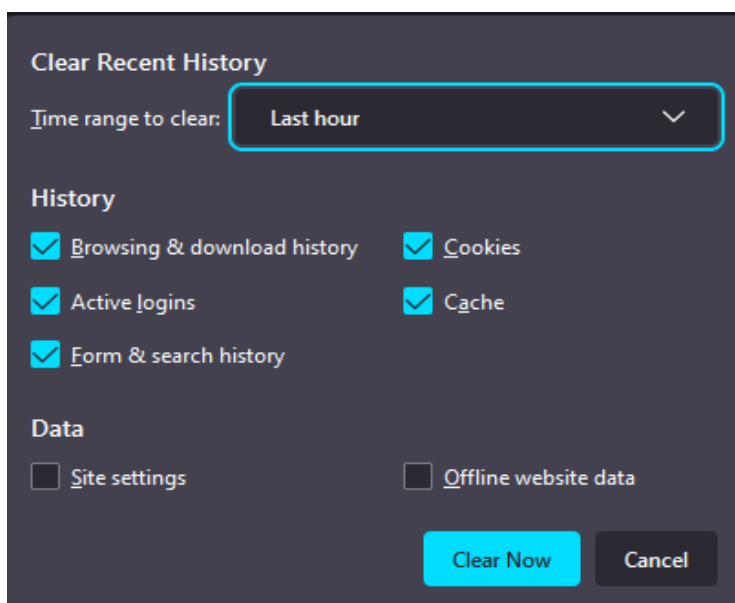
2. Click "**History**".

4. Click “Clear Now”.

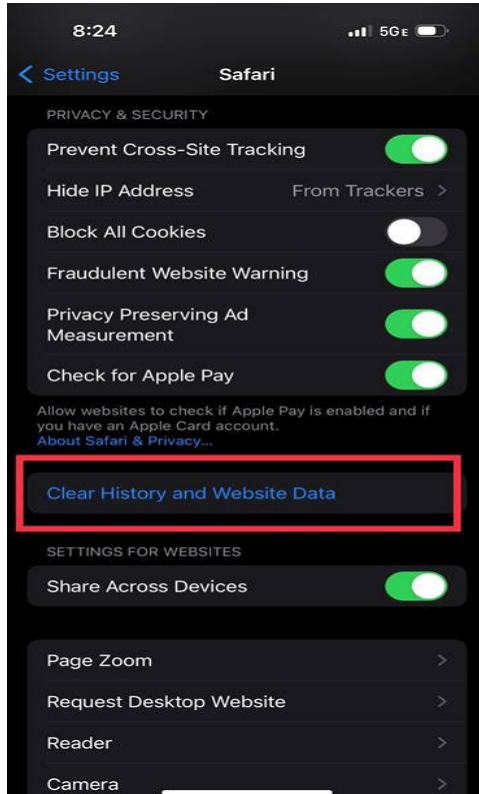


Safari iOS

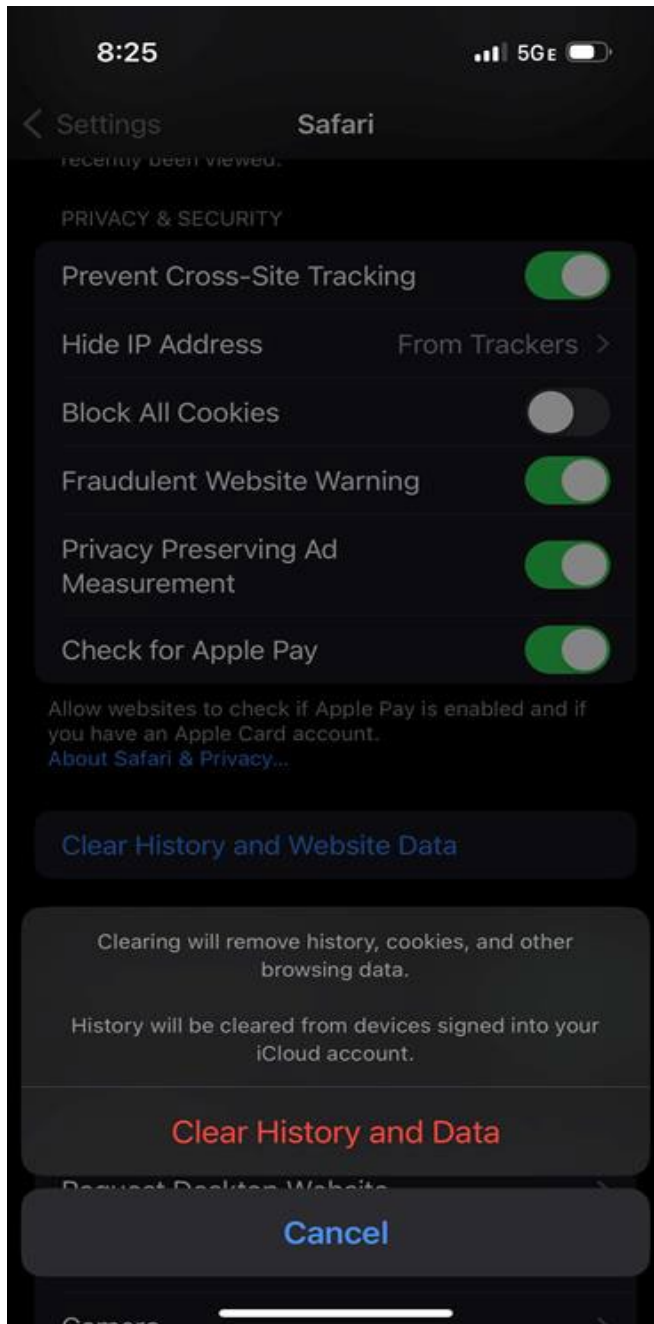
1. Go to your **Settings**  and click "**Safari**".



2. Click "**Clear History and Website Data**".

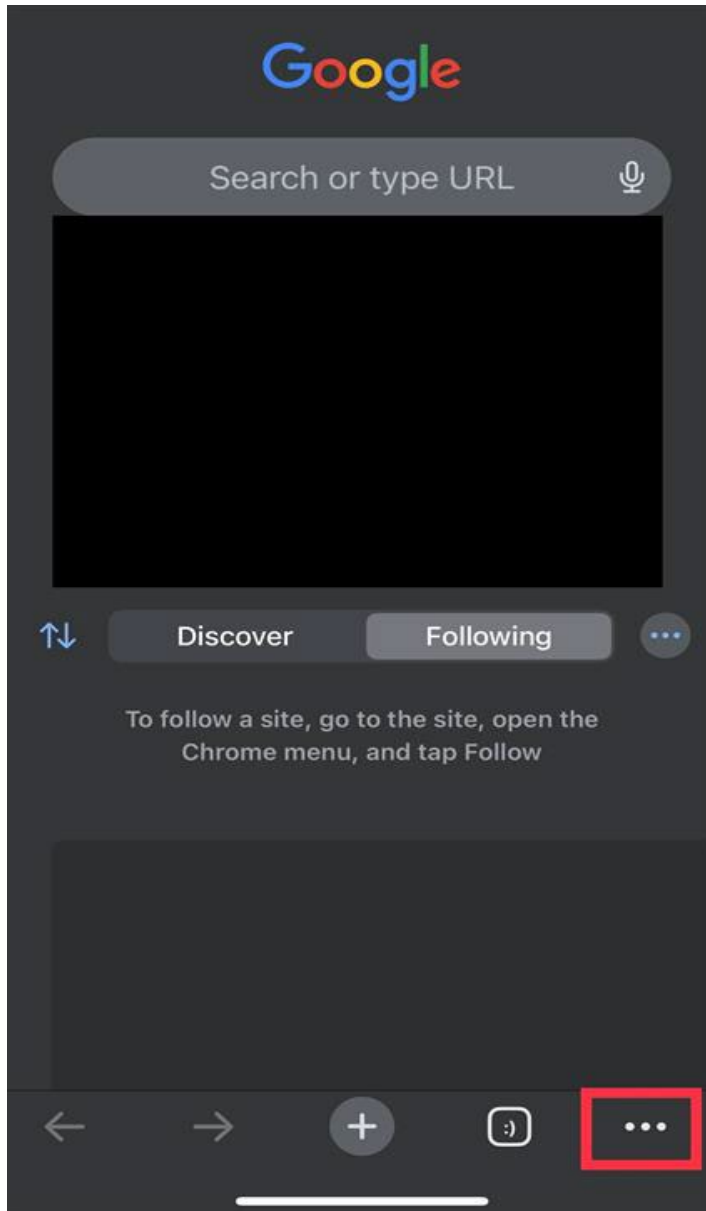

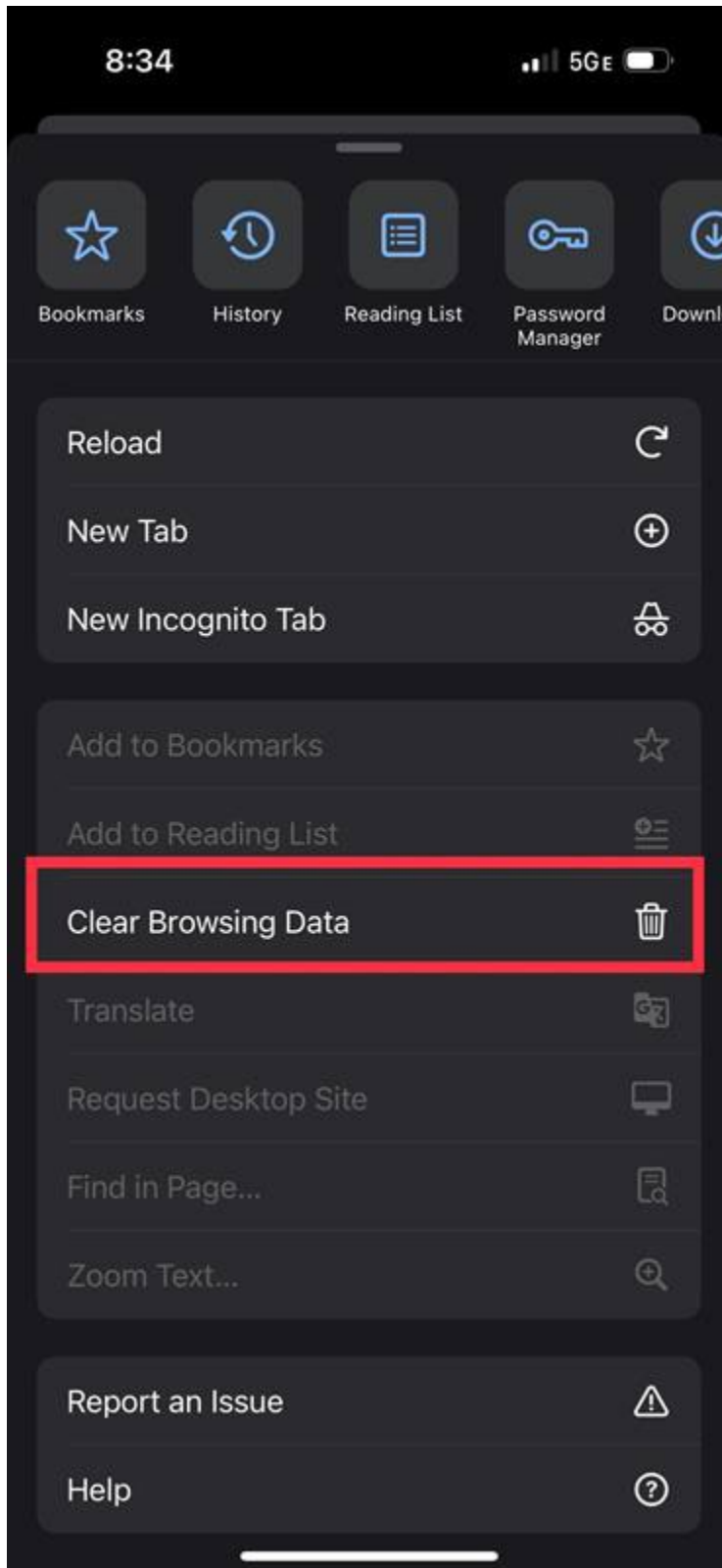


Google Chrome iOS

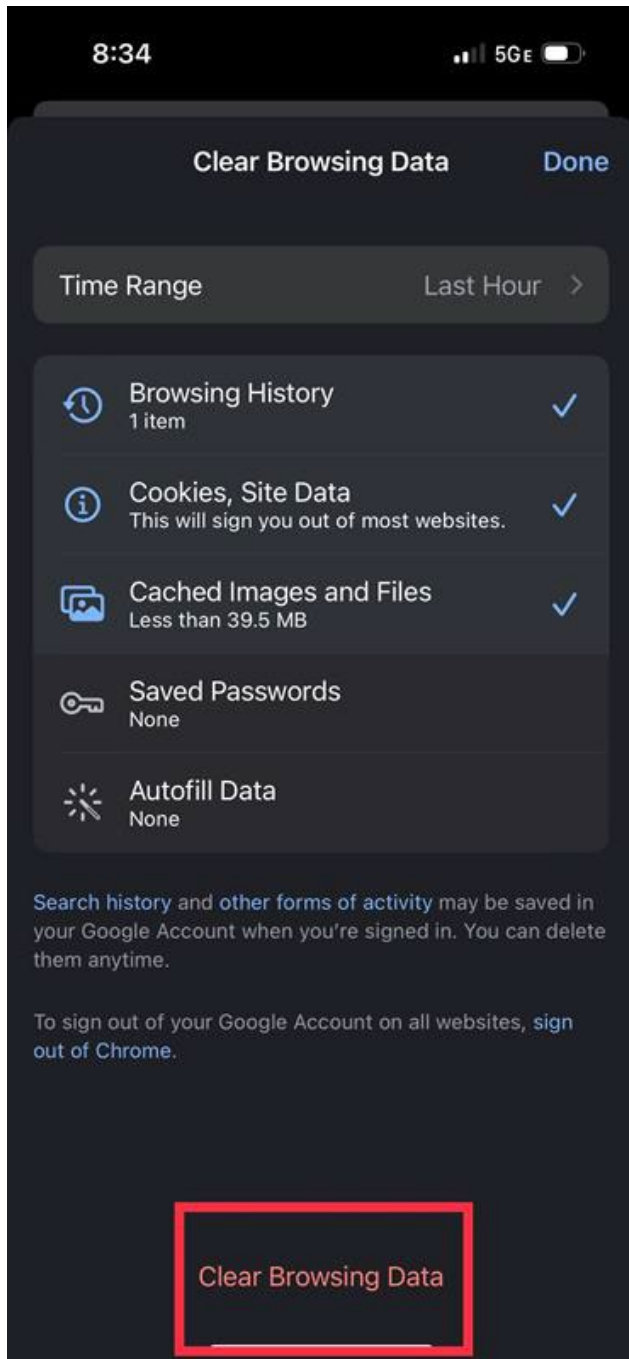
1. In the lower right corner of Google Chrome Browser, click the three dots (...).



2. Click **"Clear Browsing Data"**

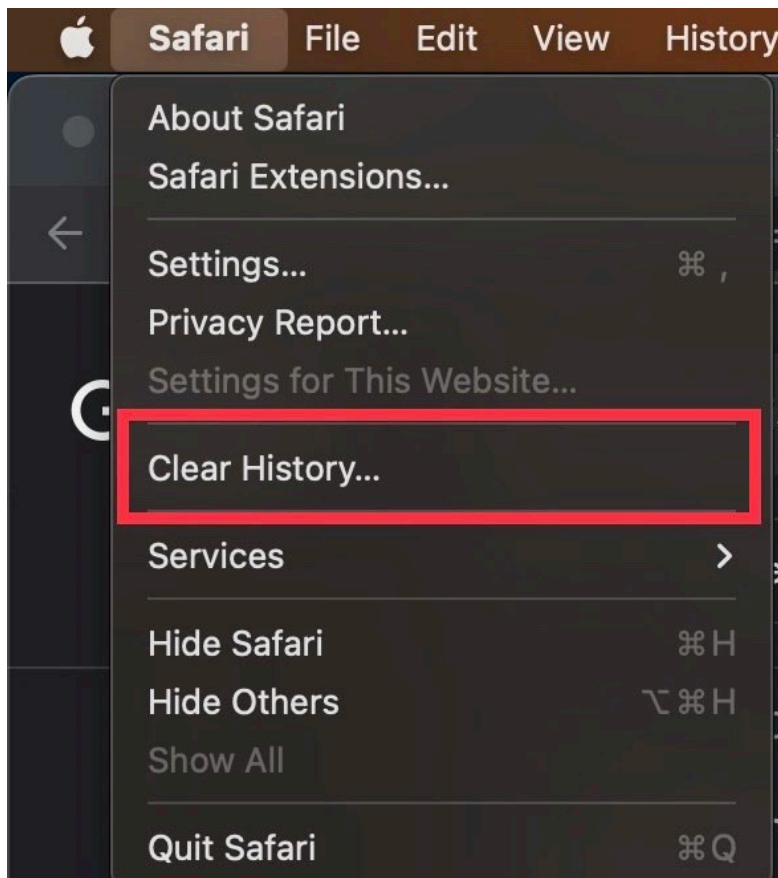

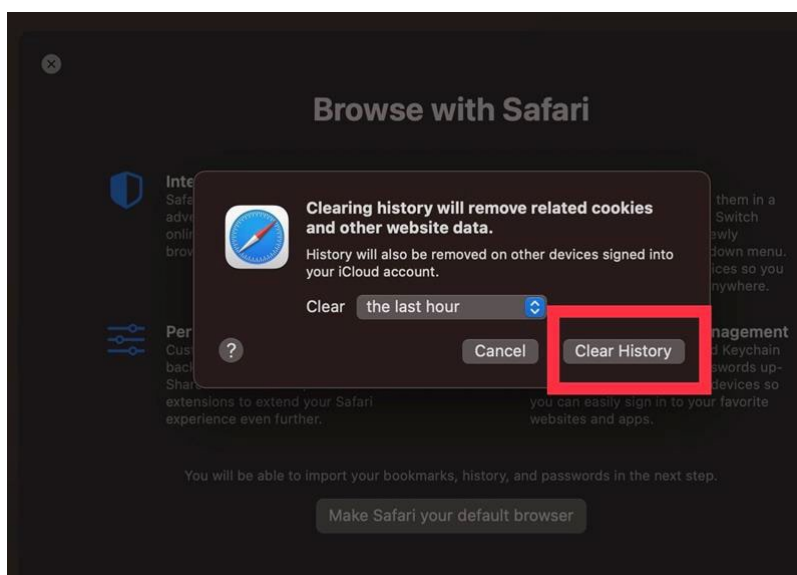


Safari macOS

1. In the menu bar, click Safari, and then click “**Clear History...**”.

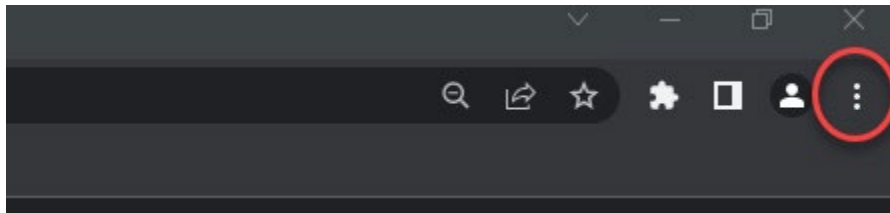


2. Click “**Clear History**”.

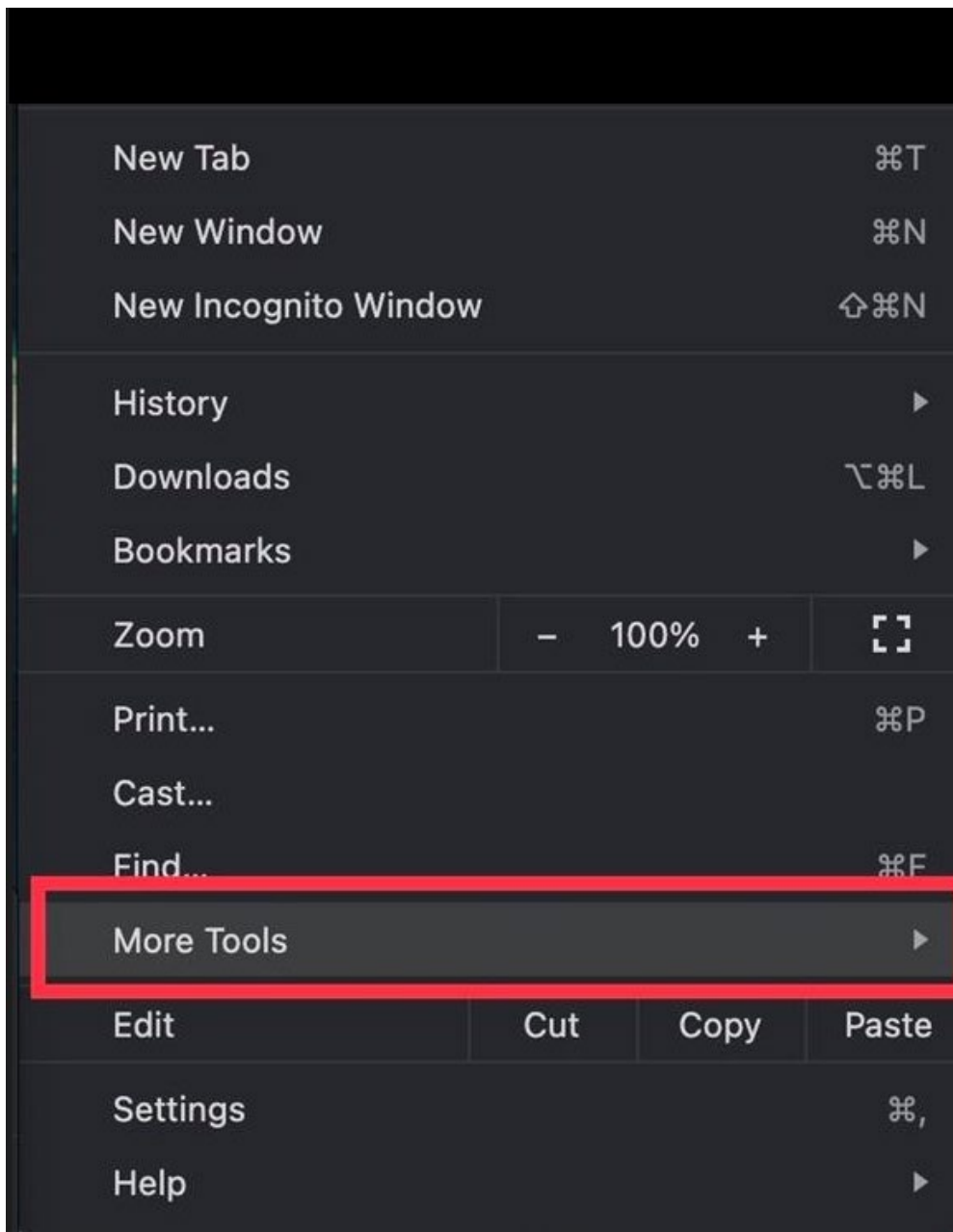


Google Chrome macOS

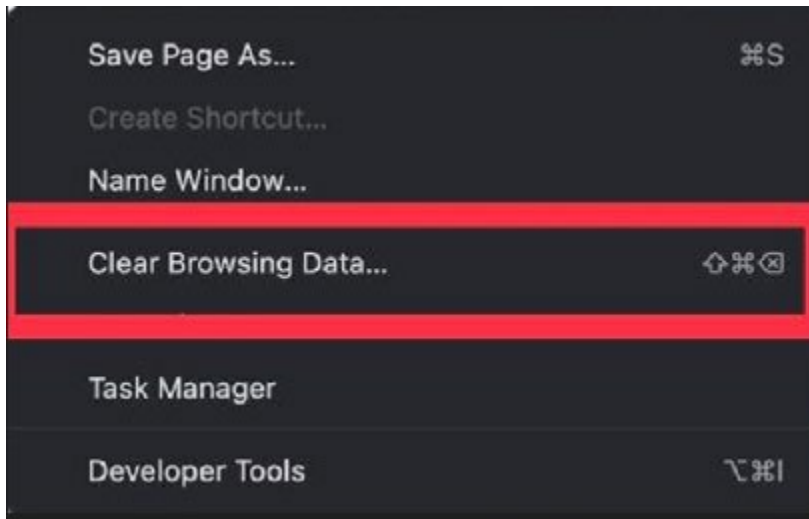
